GROUPS WILL OPEN TO VENDORS AT 7 am – NO EARLY ACCESS

The Market will open at 9 am to the Public

1. Vendors are not permitted to reserve a designated space. VENDORS ARE NOT PERMITTED TO “SELPARK”. All vendor parking must be assigned by official flea market parking personnel. The flea market reserves the right to refuse participation to any vendor who does not follow the parking rules.
2. Vendors must park in the purchased space
3. Vendors should dress appropriately-no offensive signage on clothing
4. All merchandise must be displayed on or under your table, nothing may be displayed in front of the tables
5. Items NOT permitted:
 - Food and/or drink vendors (food/drinks will be sold by Radnor Hunt)
 - Pre-approval is required for baked goods, canned or frozen food, fruit and or vegetables
 - Explosives, firearms, ammunition, flammables
 - Alcoholic beverages
 - Obscene or pornographic material
 - Live animals
 - Tobacco products
 - Intimate apparel
 - Counterfeit merchandise
6. Vendors are responsible for PA sales tax where applicable
7. Each vendor is required to keep his or her area clean
8. No one is permitted to leave behind any discarded merchandise, boxes, cartons, or trash
9. Tents permitted if confined to your vending area and are secured
10. Well behaved, leashed pets and verified service animals are permitted
11. No personal deliveries such as Door Dash
12. No flying of drones, kites, balloons etc.
13. **All vendors must vacate the Market grounds by 3 pm**

Management is not responsible for supplying any electrical service

Management reserves the right to eliminate any item being sold or given away at any time

Management is not responsible for lost, stolen or damaged items

Violators may be removed and/or barred from the Radnor Hunt Flea Market
